**PUBLIC REPORT AND FINAL ORDER FINDING NO PROBABLE CAUSE  
AND DISMISSING THE COMPLAINT**

Citizen William Jean-Louis filed the above-referenced COMPLAINT against  
RESPONDENT Eyan Ross (Ross), an employee of CH2M Hill, alleging violations of the  
Miami-Dade County Conflict of Interest and Code of Ethics Ordinance. Specifically, the  
COMPLAINT alleged violations of Sections 2-11.1 (s), *Lobbying*.

According to the facts outlined in the COMPLAINT, Ross engaged in  
unregistered lobbying when he took two North Miami Councilmembers on a site visit.  
Investigation revealed no evidence that Councilmember Scott Galvin attended the site  
visit. Investigation revealed that Councilmember Carol Keys did attend the site visit but  
there is no evidence that lobbying activity took place during the visit.

Pursuant to the Code of Miami-Dade County, Section 2-1068, the Commission on  
Ethics & Public Trust has jurisdiction to enforce the Conflict of Interest and Code of  
Ethics Ordinance, Section 2-11.1. On November 12, 2013, Ethics Commission staff  
deemed the COMPLAINT to be legally sufficient. On January 9, 2014, in closed session,  
the Ethics Commission held a probable cause hearing. The Ethics Commission found no  
probable cause and accordingly, dismissed the complaint.

Therefore it is:

**ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that the COMPLAINT C13-036 against  
respondent Ross is hereby dismissed.
