PUBLIC REPORT AND FINAL ORDER

An ethics complaint was filed against Respondent, Joseph Centorino, Executive Director of the Miami-Dade County Commission on Ethics and Public Trust. The complaint alleged that Centorino violated Section 2-11.1 (g) of the Miami-Dade County Conflict of Interest by authorizing an investigation into matters outside the jurisdiction of the Ethics Commission, specifically, a possible Sunshine Law violation in the City of Hialeah. The Ethics Commission found that Centorino did not exploit his official position by allowing an investigation of matters outside the jurisdiction of the COE. The COE was working jointly and cooperatively with the State Attorney's Office in this matter as it has often done in the past.

On April 16, 2014, in open session, the Ethics Commission found there was no probable cause to sustain the complaint and dismissed it.

Wherefore it is:

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that COMPLAINT C 13-37 against respondent Joseph Centorino is hereby concluded.
