PUBLIC REPORT AND FINAL ORDER

An ethics complaint was filed against Respondent, Angel Zayon, (Zayon) the Chief of Communications for the City of Miami. The complaint alleged that Zayon violated Section 2-11.1 (g) of the Miami-Dade County Conflict of Interest by contacting a City of Miami Assistant Police Chief in an effort to "fix" a ticket that Zayon had been issued.

Zayon was issued a citation after being involved in a minor traffic accident. On March 13, 2014, in open session, the Ethics Commission found No Probable Cause to sustain the allegation in the complaint and dismissed the case. The evidence showed that Zayon's ticket went through the normal process and procedures and there was no evidence that he tried to have the Assistant Chief intervene on his behalf.

Therefore it is:

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that COMPLAINT C 14-05 against respondent Angel Zayon is hereby concluded.
