PUBLIC REPORT AND FINAL ORDER

Complainant, Alexander J. Ott, filed the above-referenced complaint against Respondents Saul Frances (Frances), Miami Beach Parking Director; Rocio Alba (Alba), Miami Beach Assistant Parking Director; and Grady Steele (Steele), Senior Administrative Manager for the Miami Beach Parking Department. The complainant alleged that Respondents violated the Citizens' Bill of Rights, Part 1, Miami-Dade Home Rule Charter, by knowingly and willfully providing false and misleading information to the media regarding a public records request.

Pursuant to the Code of Miami-Dade County at Sec. 2-1072(b) and to the Citizens' Bill of Rights at Sec. (A)(17), the Ethics Commission is empowered to enforce the Citizens' Bill of Rights.

On June 17, 2014, in closed session, the Ethics Commission held a probable cause hearing and found that there was no probable cause to substantiate the Complaint, as Respondents provided all records in the possession of the Miami Beach Parking Department.

Therefore it is:

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that COMPLAINT C 14-20 against Respondents Frances, Alba, and Steele, is hereby dismissed.
