PUBLIC REPORT AND FINAL ORDER

Francis Rago (Rago) filed the above-referenced complaint against Respondent Erhabor Ighodaro (Ighodaro), a City of Miami Gardens Councilman. The complaint alleged that Respondent used his position as Councilman to accelerate the date of an annual local event held by the Zion AME church, in order to move the event closer to election day to benefit his campaign; in violation of Section 2-11.1(g), *Exploitation of official position prohibited*, of the Miami-Dade Conflict of Interest and Code of Ethics Ordinance (the Ordinance).

On October 8, 2014, in closed session, the Ethics Commission held a probable cause hearing and found that there was insufficient evidence to substantiate a claim that Respondent violated Section 2-11.1(g) of the Ordinance.

Therefore it is:

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that COMPLAINT C 14-32 against Respondent Erhabor Ighodaro is hereby dismissed.
