PUBLIC REPORT AND FINAL ORDER

An ethics complainant was filed by Magdalia Marmol, a private citizen, against the State of Florida, Department of Children and Families (DCF).

The complaint references on-going litigation between Complainants' daughter and DCF, apparently involving custody issues. DCF is a state agency not under the jurisdiction of the COE, pursuant to the Miami-Dade County Code at Sec. 2-1072. Furthermore, none of the allegations in the complaint fall within the jurisdiction of the Miami-Dade County Ethics Commission.

On October 8, 2014 the Ethics Commission found the complaint was not legally sufficient because it does not identify any violations or parties within the jurisdiction of the Miami-Dade County Ethics Commission.


Wherefore it is:
