PUBLIC REPORT AND FINAL ORDER

The complainant, Art Nanni, was a candidate for mayor of the Town of Cutler Bay. He filed this complaint against Peggy Bell who was his opponent in the election. Complainant alleged that Respondent or her supporters were responsible for a website, Cutlerbaywatchdog.com, which published unflattering and derogatory stories about Nanni. At a hearing on October 23, 2014, Nanni presented his case to a hearing examiner. In a separate Order, the hearing examiner found No Probable Cause that Respondent was responsible for the creation and content of the website.

Due to the fact that no connection was established between Respondent and the creation of the CutlerBaywatchdog.com website the finding of No Probable Cause as previously determined by the hearing examiner is hereby ratified and adopted by this Commission. On November 17, 2014, in closed session, the Ethics Commission found that there was No Probable Cause to sustain the complaint and dismissed it.


Wherefore it is:
