Halabi v. Winick

PUBLIC REPORT AND FINAL ORDER

Antonio Halabi (Halabi), a private citizen, filed the above-referenced complaint against Graham Winick [Winick]. Winick is the Film and Event Production manager for the City of Miami Beach. Halabi owns a restaurant in Miami Beach, the Flame Caffe and Grill. He alleges that Winick, and possibly others in the City, are engaged in a pattern of negligence and corruption by ignoring permitting guidelines in order to benefit Halabi's competitors.

After an investigation, no evidence was found to support the proposition that there was a pattern of favoritism that was engaged in by City employees that favored Halabi's competitors.

Accordingly, on May 13, 2015, in open session, the Ethics Commission found No Probable Cause to proceed with this complaint and dismissed it.


Therefore it is:
