

PUBLIC REPORT AND FINAL ORDER

Complainants, R. Diaz, C. Goordean, and M. Hernandez, filed this complaint against Gail Moses (Moses), an electronics technician for the Miami-Dade Transit Department (MDT) and the Transit Workers Union (TWU) Shop Steward.

Complainants alleged that their Shop Steward was performing in a manner that is inconsistent with union member's interests and disregarding certain policies and procedures.

A legally sufficient complaint exists where there are allegations of a violation of an ordinance within the jurisdiction of the Ethics Commission, purportedly committed by an individual within the authority of the Ethics Commission.

On July 8, 2015, in open session, the Ethics Commission dismissed this complaint as not legally sufficient based on the Advocates recommendation.

Therefore it is:

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that COMPLAINT C 15-20 is hereby concluded.
