PUBLIC REPORT AND FINAL ORDER

Complainant Alan Feuer (Feuer) filed this complaint against Miami-Dade County Transit (MDT) employees Vivian Uchdorf (Uchdorf) and Linda Reyes (Reyes).

Feuer alleged a cause of action under Section (A) (2) entitled "Truth in Government" of the Citizens' Bill of Rights (CBR) due to Reyes' refusal to provide answers to a series of questions Feuer sent her.

On May 11, 2016 the Ethics Commission found the complaint was not legally sufficient because there is no requirement under either State law or the CBR that an official or employee give out information from the records of his or her office or to submit to interrogation by a citizen who has requested public records. (*See generally*, Op. Att'y Gen. Fla. 80-57 (1980) and Op. Att'y Gen. Fla. 92-38 (1992).

Wherefore it is:

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that COMPLAINT C16-11 against both respondents is dismissed.
