PUBLIC REPORT AND FINAL ORDER

Christopher Davis (Davis), CEO of Professional Chauffeur Transportation Services, filed the above-referenced complaint against Respondent, Travis Kalanick (Kalanick), CEO of Uber. Davis alleged that Kalanick lobbied County officials between July and October, 2012, without being registered to lobby, in violation of Section 2-11.1(s) of the County Ethics Code, entitled, *Lobbying*. The complaint alleges a violation(s) which took place in 2012, beyond the three-year statute of limitations jurisdiction for the Ethics Commission.

On May 11, 2016, in closed session, the Ethics Commission's Staff Attorney recommended that the case be dismissed.

In open session, the Ethics Commission voted unanimously to find No Legal Sufficiency and dismissed the case.


Wherefore it is:
