Zisman v Dubois

PUBLIC REPORT AND FINAL ORDER

Complainant, David Zisman (Zisman), filed this complaint against the Vice-Mayor of the Village of Palmetto Bay John Dubois (Dubois).

In C16-23(A) Zisman alleged a possible violation of State Elections law for failing to include the disclaimer "Paid for and Approved by John Dubois" on an e-mail circulated by Dubois. The Ethics Commission does not enforce the Elections Law. Zisman has been advised to file his complaint with the Elections Department.

In C16-23 (B) Zisman alleged a possible violation of the Sunshine Law. The Ethics Commission does not enforce the Sunshine Law. Zisman has been advised to contact the State Attorney's Office about this matter.

On July 13, 2016 the Ethics Commission accepted the Advocate's recommendation, that this complaint was NOT LEGALLY SUFFICIENT because the allegations do not identify any violation of matters within the jurisdiction of the Ethics Commission and dismissed the case.

Wherefore it is:

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that COMPLAINT C16-23 against John Dubois is concluded.
