

PUBLIC REPORT AND FINAL ORDER

Tim Schaffer (Schaffer), Councilman of the Village of Palmetto Bay, filed this complaint against David Singer (Singer), candidate for the Village of Palmetto Bay Council. Schaffer alleged that Singer committed possible violations of State election laws for distributing campaign materials without proper disclosures and failing to report campaign-related expenditures.

A legally sufficient complaint exists where there are allegations of a violation of an ordinance within the jurisdiction of the Ethics Commission, purportedly committed by an individual within the authority of the Ethics Commission. The Ethics Commission does not enforce State Election laws.

On August 10, 2016, in closed session, the Ethics Commission's Staff Attorney recommended that the case be dismissed. In open session, the Ethics Commission voted unanimously to find No Legal Sufficiency and dismissed the case.

Wherefore it is:

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that COMPLAINT C16-26 against Respondent, David Singer, is hereby dismissed.
