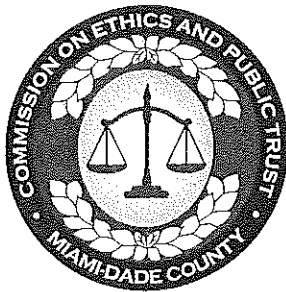

PUBLIC REPORT AND FINAL ORDER

The Advocate filed the above-captioned complaint against Leonardo Figueroa ("Respondent") for violations of Section 2-11.1(k) (2) of the County's Ethics Code (Outside Employment Statements). The complaint alleged that the Respondent failed to timely file the required annual reports disclosing his outside employment for the years 2013 and 2014.

The Respondent is employed as an Inspector for the County's Public Housing and Community Development (PHCD). The Respondent is also President of Figueroa & Daughters Builders, Inc., a corporation which provides consulting services and facilitates inspections and permit applications. In 2013 and 2014, Respondent failed to obtain approval for his outside employment as required by Section 2-11, Miami-Dade County Code. Respondent also failed to file the outside employment statements required for those years.

On October 19, 2016, in closed session, the Ethics Commission accepted the parties' Stipulation to Legal Sufficiency and Probable Cause. The Advocate presented a Settlement Agreement where Respondent would pled no contest to the allegations in the complaint and agreed to pay a Five-Hundred Dollar fine (\$500.00) in satisfaction of Count I and the Advocate would dismiss Count II.

In open session, the Ethics Commission approved the proposed Settlement Agreement.

Wherefore it is:

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that COMPLAINT C16-33 against Respondent, Leonardo Figueroa, is hereby concluded.
