**PUBLIC REPORT AND FINAL ORDER**

The complainant, Raniero Gimeno (Gimeno), a private citizen, filed this complaint against County Commissioner Daniella Levine Cava (Cava). Gimeno purported to allege that Cava "harassed" and "attempted to intimidate" him and others at a public event. Gimeno is engaged in a lawsuit with Cava's husband. Gimeno made no specific allegations about how Cava used or attempted to use her official position to harass or intimidate him.

Attempts were made to contact Gimeno in an effort to get more specific information that might support the allegation in his complaint. Gimeno advised, through his attorney that he is "standing by the statements contained in his complaint and will not be providing any additional information." On its face, the complaint is devoid of any facts sufficient to support a charge of exploitation of official position. Complainant is unwilling to provide any further information.

On May 10, 2017, the Ethics Commission accepted the Advocate's recommendation that the complaint was not legally sufficient and dismissed the complaint.

Wherefore it is:

**ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that COMPLAINT C 17-10 against respondent Daniella Levine -Cava is hereby concluded.
