**PUBLIC REPORT AND FINAL ORDER**

Complainant, Stephanie Kienzle (Kienzle), filed a Complaint against North Miami Beach Commissioner Phyllis Smith (Smith).

Kienzle alleged that at the May 16, 2017 North Miami Beach Commission meeting, Smith “put on record” that she worked three jobs. Kienzle alleged that Smith failed to disclose the third job when she filed her Statements of Financial Interest from 2012-2015.

On July 12, 2017, the Miami-Dade Commission on Ethics and Public Trust found No Probable Cause to support the allegations in the complaint. Smith’s reference to “working three jobs” was taken out of context by Kienzle. Smith referred to her “third job” as being a wife, mother and grandmother and was a figure of speech. Smith did not violate the Miami-Dade County Home Rule, Citizens’ Bill of Rights, Section (A) (2), or Section 2-11.1(i) of the Miami-Dade County Conflict of Interest and Code of Ethics Ordinance.

Wherefore it is:

**ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that Complaint C17-13 against Phyllis Smith is dismissed.
