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**PUBLIC REPORT AND FINAL ORDER**

The Advocate filed the above-captioned complaint against Lourdes Sori ("Respondent") for a violation of Section 2-11.1(s) of the County's Ethics Code (*Lobbying*) and Section 26-67 of the City of Hialeah Code (*[Lobbyist] Registration and oath*). The complaint alleged that the Respondent failed to register as a lobbyist before lobbying in the City of Hialeah between October 2014 and June 2016.

The Respondent is employed as a Senior Account Manager for Motorola Solutions Inc. (Motorola). Between 2014 and 2016, Respondent lobbied officials in the City of Hialeah without registering by: meeting with the Mayor to encourage him to invest in a new system from Motorola; addressing the City of Hialeah Council on the recommendation to award the public safety radio contract to Motorola; and, writing a letter to City officials urging them to make the public safety radio system a priority so Motorola could move forward with the contract.

On August 9, 2017, in closed session, the Miami-Dade County Ethics Commission accepted the parties' Stipulation to Probable Cause. The Staff Attorney presented a Settlement Agreement where Respondent pled no contest to the allegation in the complaint and agreed to pay a Five-Hundred Dollar fine (\$500.00) in satisfaction of Count I.

In open session, the Ethics Commission approved the proposed Settlement Agreement.
