PUBLIC REPORT AND FINAL ORDER

Jane Washington-White, a County resident, filed this complaint against "someone who works in the Housing Department" alleging that her cellphone number had been disclosed by the unidentified person(s).

A legally sufficient complaint exists where there are allegations of a violation of an ordinance within the jurisdiction of the Ethics Commission, purportedly committed by an individual within the authority of the Ethics Commission. The Ethics Commission does not enforce violations where the Respondent is not identified; the allegation is not based on personal knowledge; and, the allegation does not identify a violation within the jurisdiction of the Ethics Commission.

On February 14, 2018, in closed session, the Ethics Commission's Staff Attorney recommended that the case be dismissed due to lack of legal sufficiency. In open session, the Ethics Commission voted unanimously to find No Legal Sufficiency and dismissed the case.


Wherefore it is:
