**PUBLIC REPORT AND FINAL ORDER**

Complainant Rodney Pete (Pete) filed eight complaints, two of the complaints against Miami-Dade County Circuit Court Judge William Thomas and the remaining six complaints against six, different, Florida attorneys.

The allegations against Judge Thomas appear to involve allegations of unlawfully issuing a final foreclosure and the allegations against the six attorneys appear to involve allegations of fraud.

The Miami-Dade County Commission on Ethics and Public Trust has no jurisdiction over the subject matter of these complaints. They are more appropriate for the Florida Bar and the Judicial Qualifications Commission. A copy of the complaints was sent back to the complainant advising him of the more appropriate agencies to handle these complaints.

On March 14, 2018, the Ethics Commission agreed with the Advocate's recommendation that the Ethics Commission does not have jurisdiction over the persons and subject matter of these eight complaints and found them to be Not Legally Sufficient and dismissed them.

Wherefore it is:

**ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that complaint C18-11-02 is hereby dismissed.
