Powell v. Eddie Lim

PUBLIC REPORT AND FINAL ORDER

Complainant Norman Powell (Powell) is the Village Attorney for North Bay Village (NBV). Powell filed this complaint against NBV Commissioner Eddie Lim (Lim) alleging he engaged in a voting conflict when he voted on a liquor license variance for a restaurant owner client whom Lim represented.

Investigation determined that Lim did not have any of the prohibited relationships with Kushi, the applicant for the variance. Lim was compensated by the landlord, Scott Greenwald, and there was no additional compensation due him as a condition of Kushi obtaining the variance. Accordingly, he did not have a voting conflict under the Ethics Code.

On June 20, 2018, in open session, the Ethics Commission accepted the Advocate's recommendation that there was No Probable Cause to believe that Respondent, Eddie Lim (Lim) violated Section 2-11.1 (d) of the Miami-Dade County Conflict of Interest and Code of Ethics ordinance and dismissed the complaint.

Wherefore it is:

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that COMPLAINT C18-18-04 is hereby dismissed.
