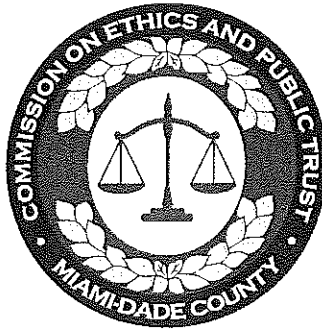

PUBLIC REPORT AND FINAL ORDER

The complainant, Richard Chervony (Chervony), a private citizen, filed this complaint against North Bay Village Vice-Mayor Andreana Jackson and North Bay Village City Attorney Norman Powell. Chervony alleged that Jackson and Powell filed police reports in violation of Section 837.05, Florida Statutes; that Powell misused his public position by using police resources to investigate false allegations against Chervony, in violation of Section 838.022, Fla. Stats.; and, that Powell's false allegations against Chervony, addressed in a letter to the Commission, constituted defamation.

The allegations made by Chervony are not under the jurisdiction of the Ethics Commission and more appropriately handled by other courts or agencies.<sup>1</sup>

On June 20, 2018, the Ethics Commission accepted the Staff Attorney's recommendation that the complaint was not legally sufficient and dismissed the complaint.

Wherefore it is:

**ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that COMPLAINT C 18-19-05 against Respondents Andreana Jackson and Norman Powell is hereby concluded.
