PUBLIC REPORT AND FINAL ORDER

An anonymous person filed this complaint against Al Maloof.

Section 2-1074 (a)(2) of the Code of Miami-Dade County provides that a legally sufficient complaint is one that is "(i) executed on a form prescribed by the Ethics Commission, (ii) based substantially upon the personal knowledge of the complainant and (iii) *signed under oath or affirmation by the complaining person.*" (Emphasis added)

The instant complaint was filed anonymously and is not signed under oath or affirmation by the complaining person.

On July 18, 2018 the Ethics Commission accepted the Advocate's recommendation that the complaint was Not Legally Sufficient and dismissed it.

Wherefore it is:

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that complaint C18-24-06 is hereby dismissed.
