PUBLIC REPORT AND FINAL ORDER

Complainant, Opal Jones (Jones) filed this complaint against City of Doral Landfill Division Supervisor Frank Gomez (Gomez) alleging, among other things, that Gomez abused the authority of his official position by promoting someone named Keith Lynn to the position of Waste Scale Operations Supervisor. Jones alleged disparate treatment and a hostile work environment.

Section 2-1067 of the COE's enabling ordinance states specifically that: "It is not the intent of the County Commission that the Ethics Commission serve as a personnel board resolving personnel matters involving County and municipal employees." The Ethics Commission has no jurisdiction over such matters unless there is an allegation of a violation of an ordinance within the enforcement authority of the agency. This complaint contained no such allegation.

On August 15, 2018 the Ethics Commission accepted the Advocate's recommendation that the complaint was Not Legally Sufficient and dismissed it.

Wherefore it is:

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that complaint C18-26-07 is hereby dismissed.
