PUBLIC REPORT AND FINAL ORDER

Complainant, Gary Pastorella (Pastorella), filed this complaint against City of Palmetto Bay Councilman David Singer (Singer).

The complaint failed to specifically allege any matter within the jurisdiction of the Miami-Dade County Commission on Ethics and Public Trust.

The complaint made numerous allegations. It alleged that Singer started a Political Action Committee (PAC) called "Truth over Politics." It also alleged that Singer operates a Facebook page called "Truth Beyond Politics." Allegedly, the PAC and the Facebook page advocate for the defeat of certain candidates for political office in Palmetto Bay.

Additionally, Pastorella alleged that Singer registered a Florida non-profit corporation called "Concerned Citizens of Old Cutler" despite being aware of a certain other group (to which Pastorella belongs) group called "Concerned Citizens of Old Cutler" (CCOC).

Pastorella alleged violations of Florida Statute 106.03 (1) (a). This statute relates to the registration of political committees and electioneering communications organizations (ECO's). The Ethics Commission has no jurisdiction to enforce Florida Statutes.

On October 10, 2018 the Ethics Commission agreed with the recommendation of the Advocate that the complaint was Not Legally Sufficient and dismissed the complaint.

Wherefore it is:

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that COMPLAINT C18-34-09 against David Singer is dismissed.
