PUBLIC REPORT AND FINAL ORDER

Complainant Vaughn Mulder (Mulder) alleged that Chief Andres Alvarez (Alvarez) of the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Marine Services Division, is deficient in his dive certifications and proficiency tests and has falsified information on his dive log records.

The Ethics Commission agreed with the recommendation of the Advocate that this complaint alleges a personnel matter that is best handled administratively by the Fire Chief. The complaint fails to allege any actions which would constitute a violation of the Conflict of Interest or Code of Ethics ordinance.

Because this complaint does not identify any violations within the jurisdiction of the Miami-Dade County Ethics Commission, the complaint is NOT LEGALLY SUFFICIENT and should be dismissed.

On April 10, 2019 the Ethics Commission accepted the Advocate's recommendation that the complaint be dismissed.

Wherefore it is:

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that COMPLAINT C 19-12-03 against Respondent Andres Alvarez is hereby dismissed.
