PUBLIC REPORT AND FINAL ORDER

The complainant, David Singer (Singer), councilmember for the Village of Palmetto Bay, filed this complaint against Councilmember Marsha Matson (Matson) alleging that Matson violated the Miami-Dade County Conflict of Interest and Code of Ethics Ordinance by instructing the Village Manager through emails to take certain actions to benefit herself and her political supporters to the exclusion of the general public.

Investigation revealed that the emails consisted of typical requests made by councilmembers in the conduct of official business to address matters of public concern and were not in any way improper or in violation of the Ethics Code.

On July 17, 2019, the Ethics Commission voted to find no probable cause and dismissed the complaint.

Wherefore it is:

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that COMPLAINT C 19-21-05 against Respondent Marsha Matson is hereby concluded.
