PUBLIC REPORT AND FINAL ORDER

Citizen complainant, Leon Craig (Craig), filed a complaint with the Ethics Commission alleging that an unknown County employee illegally parked a County vehicle in a handicapped parking space in the vicinity of 14350 NW 7th Avenue, Miami, on or about July 25, 2019. Craig further alleged that the unknown County employee, when confronted by Craig, attempted to intimidate him. COE investigative staff were able to determine that the County vehicle in question was assigned to Internal Services Department employee Juan Rodriguez (Rodriguez) on the day in question.

The County employee's behavior as described by Craig may violate local parking laws and may be conduct unbecoming a County employee. However, no violations of the Conflict of Interest and Code of Ethics ordinance are implicated. Rodriguez's actions involve personnel matters that should be addressed administratively by his supervisors.

On September 11, 2019, in open session, the Ethics Commission agreed with the Advocate's recommendation that the complaint be found Not Legally Sufficient and dismissed it. The Commission further ordered that a copy of the complaint and supporting documentation be forwarded to the Director of the Internal Services Department to proceed with whatever personnel action she deems appropriate.

Wherefore it is:

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that COMPLAINT C19-31-08 is hereby dismissed.
