Dear Ms. Uppal,

You inquire whether Colonial Life Insurance representatives must register to lobby before they attend a meeting, *at their request*, to discuss information they previously shared with Commissioner Monestime and provide additional insight on how they can help Miami-Dade County cut employee benefit costs.

# **Background**

Colonial Life Insurance (Colonial) is a company which offers supplemental health benefits for life insurance, accident insurance, disability insurance, etc. Colonial representatives recently met with Commissioner Monestime to share information "regarding ways of bringing about cost savings to the county in the area of employee benefits." Mr. Paulcin, Colonial's Development Manager, has requested another meeting with you to further discuss the company's products and services. When requested to complete the lobbyist registration, Mr. Paulicin indicated that they are not lobbyists therefore, they do not need to register. He further requested to register as a County vendor and confirmed they did not wish to register as lobbyists.

The County's Human Resources Department continues to review and seek RFPs on expiring contracts for the numerous County employee benefit program and life insurance plans. *See* <u>Human Resources</u> <u>Department Business Plan for Fiscal Years 2017-2018</u>, February 13, 2017.

#### <u>Analysis</u>

The County Ethics Code at Section 2-11.1(s), *Lobbying*, requires all persons, firms or corporations employed or retained by a principal who seek to encourage the passage, defeat or modifications of any ordinance, resolution, *action* or decision which may *foreseeably* be reviewed by County officials, to register as lobbyists with the Clerk of the Board. *See* <u>Lobbying FAQs</u>; INQ 17-210. Individuals who seek to meet with County personnel to discuss their company's interests in an effort to persuade the County to transact business with their company in the foreseeable future are lobbyists and are thus required to register with the Clerk of the Board prior to lobbying. *See* RQO 10-28. Consequently, if Mr. Paulicin is the person designated by Colonial to meet with you and other County personnel to discuss how Colonial's

products or services will benefit Miami-Dade County in the area of employee benefits, he must register to lobby.

Mr. Paulicin wishes to register as a County vendor. Miami-Dade County has instituted a vendor registration process in order to avoid delays in the event a vendor is recommended for a contract award. Registered vendors have their company name added to a list used by Procurement and other County departments to obtain quotes for goods and services. *Refer to* Miami-Dade County official website. The County Ethics Code does not require vendors to register as lobbyists *unless* they attempt to persuade or influence County personnel to purchase their product or service. Consequently, the County Ethics Code does not preclude Colonial Life from registering as a County vendor; however, any activity which meets the definition of lobbying discussed herein requires registration.

This opinion is based on the facts as presented herein. If any of these facts change, please contact us.
