Pursuant to the Miami-Dade Water and Sewer Department (WASD) Consent Decree and Capital Improvement Programs Acceleration Ordinance, Section 2-8.2.12 of the Code of Miami-Dade County, it is recommended that the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee approve the interchanging of two (2) previously awarded Non-Exclusive Professional Services Agreements.

EAC Consulting, Inc. (EAC) was originally awarded Agreement No.16EAC001, which contract is for engineering design and related services for the design of large diameter water pipelines Group B (Non-Ocean Outfall Legislation Projects). The total compensation amount is \$5,500,000 with a total contract term of six (6) years. A copy of the Contract Award Recommendation is attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

Jacobs Engineering Group Inc. (Jacobs) was originally awarded Agreement No. 17JEGI001 for engineering design and related services for the design of large diameter wastewater pipelines as well as sanitary sewer force mains and sanitary sewer gravity interceptors Group A (Ocean Outfall Legislation Projects). The total compensation amount is \$5,500,000 with a total contract term of six (6) years. A copy of the Contract Award Recommendation is attached hereto as Exhibit "B".

Under the proposal course of action, EAC would take over the scope of work originally assigned to Jacobs for Group A projects (Ocean Outfall Legislation Projects), and Jacobs would assume the scope of work originally assigned to EAC for Group B projects (Non-Ocean Outfall Legislation Projects). The reason for interchanging the Agreements is to avoid a potential organizational conflict of interest that could arise due to the acquisition of CH2M Hill by Jacobs Engineering because CH2M Hill is WASD's Owner's Representative for Ocean Outfall Legislation (OOL) Projects and would be directly supervising itself if the contracts are not interchanged.

Pursuant to Section 6 of Agreement No. 17JEGI002, "Organizational Conflicts of Interest", WASD's Director has proposed the above change in order to address any potential organizational conflict of interest. Both firms have mutually agreed to this change.

BACKGROUND:

On October 11, 2017, WASD received a letter from CH2M Hill, Inc. (CH2M) advising of a possible acquisition by Jacobs. See October 11, 2017 letter attached hereto as Exhibit "C". On December 15, 2017, the merger between CH2M and Jacobs was formalized.

Due to the merger, WASD recognized a potential conflict of interest between Jacobs and CH2M because CH2M is performing as WASD's Owner's Representative for Professional Engineering Services for the OOL under Agreement No. 14CH2M006. As the Owner's Representative, CH2M Honorable Carlos A. Gimenez Project No. E15-WASD-01 Page 2

was to oversee work performed by Jacobs under Agreement No. 17JEGI002 for projects relating to the OOL; therefore, in order to avoid a potential conflict of interest between Jacobs and CH2M and to maintain the required contract capacity under both OOL and Non-OOL WASD managed projects, Jacobs and EAC have agreed to WASD's proposal to interchange their awarded contracts.

Additionally, WASD forwarded a copy of Exhibit "C" to the Office of the Inspector General (OIG) and to the Commission of Ethics (COE), pursuant to Section 6 (7) of Agreement No. 17JEGI002, which states that the WASD Director will forward a copy of the written explanation of the methodology used to address an identified organization conflict of interest to the OIG and COE. Neither the OIG or COE have objected to WASD's proposed course of action.

Further, due to the merger and in accordance with Section 39 of CH2M's Agreement No. 14CH2M006, WASD has recommended approval of the attached Assignment of Agreements because CH2M has legally become Jacobs. A copy of the "Assignment of Agreement" is attached hereto as Exhibit "D".

DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY:

Upon the approval of both interchanged contract award recommendations, pursuant to the provisions of Section 2-8.2.12 of the Miami-Dade County Code, the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee will have the authority to execute, amend and terminate the Agreements and to resolve disputes. Additionally, pursuant to the provisions of Sections 2-8.2.12 (4)(d) and (e) of the Code, the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee will have the authority to amend and/or extend the Agreements to complete any unfinished work, waive liquidated damages, negotiate and settle claims, and execute change orders that do not exceed ten percent (10%) of the base contract amounts.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

The scope of work will remain the same with the exception that Jacobs will perform work under Group B for Non-OOL Projects and EAC will perform work under Group A for OOL Projects. The scope of work consists of engineering services for utility design, including planning and permitting assistance during construction for system upgrades to large sewer pipelines for Group A and large water pipelines for Group B. The scope of services consists of complete design services, which includes, but is not limited to: performance of preliminary route analysis; site investigations; surveying; maintenance of traffic plans; hydraulic analysis; coordination with other utilities; coordination with other municipalities and the public; preparation of design reports; preparation of drawings and contract specifications; preparation of design-build criteria packages; assistance during the permitting and procurement phases; and engineering support during construction. Engineering support during construction is anticipated to include. but is not limited to: periodic site inspections; attendance at meetings; review of shop drawings; responding to requests for information; reviewing claims and potential change orders; reviewing contract schedules and schedule of values; and reviewing as-built drawings. Project coordination services are anticipated to include, but are not limited to: establishing a plan to implement projects; establishing and tracking project schedules, budgets and deadlines; preparing status reports; and attending meetings as requested.

RE: Potential Conflict of Interest — Response

Dear Mr. Adair:

The Miami-Dade Water and Sewer Department (WASD) received your letter dated October 11, 2017 advising WASD of the possible acquisition of CH2M Hill Companies Ltd. (CH2M) by Jacobs Engineering Group Inc. (Jacobs). It is our understanding that the merger was formalized on December 15, 2017.

Because Jacobs has now merged with CH2M, an organizational conflict of interest could result if CH2M, as WASD's representative for Professional Engineering Services related to the Ocean Outfall Legislation program ("OOL") pursuant to PSA 14CH2M006, were to oversee the work that Jacobs will be doing on PSA 16JEGI001 and PSA 17JEGI002, which projects involve and/or could involve work on the OOL. Specifically, Section 6 (A)(2) of PSA 16JEGI001 and PSA 17JEGI002 defines an "organizational conflict of interest" as:

"... a situation in which an Engineer: (a) under the Contract, or any part thereof, including a particular work order or defined task, is required to exercise judgment to assist the COUNTY in a matter...and the ENGINEER has a direct or indirect financial or other interest at stake in the matter, so that a reasonable person might have concern that when performing Work under the AGREEMENT, the ENGINEER may be improperly influenced by its own interests rather than the best interest of the COUNTY..."

Consequently, the County has considered the various options available to avoid a potential conflict of interest and has decided on the following measures.

PSA 16JEGI001

At the time of contract selection and assignment for "Engineering Design and Related Services for the Design of Large Diameter Wastewater Pipelines as well as Sanitary Sewer Force Mains and Sanitary Sewer Gravity Interceptors **Group A** (Ocean Outfall Legislation Projects) and **Group B** (Non-Ocean Outfall Legislation Projects)" in January 2017, the County selected eight firms; six

were assigned to the OOL and two were assigned to Non-OOL WASD-managed projects. Jacobs was awarded one of the OOL contracts (PSA 16JEGI001) on January 20, 2017.

On July 27, 2017, CH2M submitted a recommendation for Jacobs to handle Task Authorization No. 1 for design of OOL Project SL-3B (wastewater transmission force main), which recommendation has been awaiting WASD approval. Now, however, in light of the merger, continuing to have Jacobs work on this project with CH2M supervising its work would present an organizational conflict of interest as that term is defined in the PSA. Accordingly, WASD never approved this Task Authorization and reassigned it to another design consultant under the OOL contracts (Group A).

Notably, in order to maintain the required contract capacity under both OOL and Non-OOL WASD-managed projects, WASD will be seeking approval to transfer one of the firms assigned to Non-OOL WASD-managed projects to work under the direction of the OOL Program Consultant, and Jacobs' contract will be transferred to Non-OOL WASD-managed projects. These contract transfers will be presented to the Board of County Commissioners for approval.

PSA 17JEGI002

At the time of contract selection and assignment for "Engineering Design and Related Services for the Improvements, Upgrades and Expansion of Regional and Booster Wastewater Pump Stations and Related Facilities Necessary for WASD's Capital Improvement Projects", the County awarded two PSAs. Jacobs was awarded one of these two PSA, Agreement 17JEGI002, effective February 21, 2017. Significantly, some of the tasks to be performed under this contract will involve OOL projects; however, other tasks under this contract will be for general WASD capital improvements.

On September 19, 2017, CH2M submitted a recommendation for Task Authorization No.1 under this PSA for design of OOL Project SP-1 (Southwest Booster Pump Station), which has been awaiting approval by WASD. WASD has determined that, in order to avoid a conflict of interest on this particular task, Task Authorization No. 1 was reassigned to another firm that received a PSA under this contract.

To avoid any other possible conflict of interest, WASD will internally manage Jacobs' PSA and will not assign any tasks that involve or relate to the OOL Program.

PSA 14CH2M006

Lastly, as stated above CH2M was awarded PSA 14CH2M006 titled "Owner's Representative for Professional Engineering Services Relating to the State of Florida's Ocean Outfall

Legislation and Miami-Dade County's Wastewater System" on October 29, 2014. Since CH2M has now officially merged with Jacobs, Jacobs has requested, as laid out in the Contract under Section 39, for "Assignment of Agreement". WASD is in favor of this request because CH2M has now legally become Jacobs and both companies are now one and the same. WASD has directed CH2M to work with Miami-Dade Internal Services Department to ensure this request follows the prescribed County processes.
