Mr. Davis:

This is in response to your memo to the Aviation Department in connection with the background check on the selection committee members appointed on RFQ No. MDAD 17-04 (Tier 2), for MDAD Airport Signage Design, Fabrication and Installation. The memo indicates that one of the members, Hernan Lopez, Graphic Unit Supervisor for ISD/DCS, currently supervises a county contract with one of the respondents to this RFQ, Acolite Claude United Signs Company, Inc. (ACU)

The fact that a selection committee members has supervisory authority over a respondent to a competitive procurement does not create any legal voting conflict of interest for that member under Section 2-11.1(v) of the County Code of Ethics. There is no direct interest by Mr. Lopez in the contract, nor does he have a relationship with ACU that would prevent him from voting on the selection committee under that section.

As you know, this agency also looks beyond the Ethics Code on procurement issues such as these, to ascertain whether there may be an appearance of a conflict that could affect the public trust in the integrity of the procurement process. Absent some other factor, the mere fact that one of the members has interactions with a respondent in connection with the members county duties would not, in my opinion create such an issue. In fact, it may be valuable to have an individual such a board who is personally familiar with the work of one or more of the responding firms, particularly where the member also has come special expertise in the services that are being sought by the county. I have spoken with Mr. Lopez, who has expressed that he feels that he has only a professional relationship with this firm and that he believes that he can be completely fair in the selection process.

Therefore, it is my opinion that Mr. Lopez should be permitted to serve on this committee.
