Ms. Martinez:

This is in response to the memo from Thomas B. Davis, Esq., Director, Policy & Legislation Division, Office of Miami-Dade County Commission Auditor regarding Project No. E-16-MDAD-08 (Substitution No. 1) – General Special Systems Engineering Services. The background check on members of the selection committee, done pursuant to R-449-14 revealed that one of the members, Juan Paan, an employee of Miami-Dade County Aviation Department, was previously employed by Burns and McDonnell Engineering Company, Inc., a respondent on the project, between 1988 and 1991.

I have conferred with Mr. Paan, who indicates that he left the employment with Burns under amicable circumstances; has no close personal or social relationships with anyone at the company; and has no ownership interest in or other formal or financial ties to the company. He did state that he oversees the company in connection with its performance as a subcontractor on a County contract at MDAD.

This agency conducts reviews of these issues under Section 2-11.1(v) of the County Ethics Code, which governs voting conflicts by members of County advisory and quasi-judicial boards. We also consider whether there is an appearance of impropriety created and make a recommendation based on R-449-14 and Ethics Commission Rule of Procedure 2.1(b).

There is no voting conflict for Mr. Paan under Section 2-11.1(v) since the decision on this project will not directly affect Mr. Paan, and Mr. Paan has no relationship with the company that might create a conflict. Additionally, I do not find that there is any appearance of impropriety where Mr. Paan has not been employed by the company since 1991 and has no current personal or business relationships with the company or its employees. The fact that Mr. Paan may supervise or oversee work done by the company at the airport does not create either a conflict or an appearance of a conflict.
