Henry Gilman with the County Attorney's Office called and asked about a former MIA employee, who left the County two years ago, and is currently working for company that is interested in doing business at the airport. The former employee wishes to meet with Aviation Department personnel in hopes of persuading MIA to purchase products the company is selling. I advised Mr. Gilman that the "Two Year Rule" prohibits former employees from lobbying the County for two years after they leave the employ of the County. There is no bar against working for a company that is doing business with the County or wishes to do business with the County, provided the ex-employee is not part of the lobbying effort.
