Section 2-11.1(q) of the Conflict of Interest ordinance prohibits any employee from lobbying the County for two years after they have left county employment. A former employee, subject to this rule, is lobbying if they meet with county staff in an effort to persuade staff regarding any matter that will require action by the County Manager(or his or her designee), the Mayor, the Board of County Commissioners or any advisory board. If the employee left more than two years ago, they may lobby staff if they register as a lobbyist.
