The only post-employment provision in the ethics code is a prohibition against lobbying the County for two years after you separate from County service. The only obvious conflict would be for you to mediate cases that you handled as an Assistant County Attorney and I am certain you would not be called upon to mediate under those circumstances. There is no conflict for you under the County ethics rules to serve as a mediator and receive partial compensation from the County.
