Based on your description of your activities with the Performing Arts Center and your job duties with the County, I see no conflict that would prohibit you from working as a Tier Leader during performances at the Performing Arts Center. Please understand that your County department needs to approve your request for outside employment and you have to report the income you generate during the calendar year from this endeavor by July 1st of the following year. In other words, if you are compensated for Tier Leader work in 2008, you have to report the income to the County Supervisor of Elections by July 1, 2009.
