I received a telephone call from Jordan Leonard, Councilmember Bay Harbor Islands, on November 10, 2008 and he asked whether he had a conflict regarding a variance before the Town Council tonight. An applicant is seeking a variance in a multi-family dwelling to repair his dock. Applicant was cited by the Town, and he needs a variance due to a conflict between the requirements of DERM and the limitations placed on dock extensions by the Town. Councilmember Leonard and his family used to live at this location and know the current owner. Leonard indicates he has not spoken to the owner in three years.

Under the circumstances, Councilmember Leonard has no conflict of interest which would preclude him from participating in or voting on this matter. He does not stand to profit from this vote and he does not have a special relationship with the applicant.
