Dear Commissioner Leonard:

As we discussed today, the Miami-Dade County Ethics Code does not prevent you from serving as a council member in the town of Bay Harbor Islands and, simultaneously, serving on the board of directors of your cooperative building owners' association—a private for-profit corporation within the town of Bay Harbor Islands. Additionally, no ethics conflicts are reasonably foreseeable based on this dual service, particularly since the town has recently created a separate entity to oversee planning and zoning matters.

If an issue were to come before the town council that would benefit your cooperative association or members of the association in a manner distinct from the public generally, you may wish to obtain an ethics opinion clarifying your duties as an elected official.
