Re: INQ 09-07 Registering as a County Vendor

Dear Mr. Barnes:

In correspondence to our office on January 28, 2009, you said that you wish to register your business, ROBERT BARNES & ASSOCIATES, as a county vendor.

You stated that you serve as a board member in a quasi-judicial capacity on a Miami-Dade County Board of Rules and Appeals.

It is the opinion of the Ethics Commission staff that you and your firm, ROBERT BARNES & ASSOCIATES, may register to contract with the county as long as the contract you enter into is not subject to the regulation, oversight, management, policy-setting, or quasi-judicial authority of the board on which you serve.

This opinion is consistent with previous ethics opinions dealing with similar facts and based on the Miami-Dade County Conflict of Interest and Code of Ethics Ordinance at Section 2-11.1(c)(3). In that section, members of advisory boards and quasi-judicial boards are permitted to enter into county contracts, individually or through a business entity in which the member or an immediate family member has a controlling financial interest, as long as the contract is not controlled in any way by the board on which the member serves.
