In correspondence to our office on August 7, 2009, you stated that you wish to register your company, MAC CONCRETE, INC., *dba* CITY BENEATH CITY PUMPING, as a County vendor.

You are currently employed by the Miami-Dade Board of Education as a substitute teacher in the Miami-Dade County Public Schools.

As a substitute teacher employed by the Board of Education, you do not fall within the jurisdiction of the Miami-Dade County Code of Ethics. The Code of Ethics identifies conflicts of interests related to County employees and their immediate family members. School Board employees are *not* County employees. You further stated that you have no immediate family members who are employed by Miami-Dade County.
