## Hello Nicole,

An employee of a corporation who simply attends a Commission meeting, speaks in favor or against the passage of an item, and <u>does not lobby as part of the normal scope of his employment</u> is not a lobbyist.

Under these circumstances, it is assumed that the employee is speaking for himself only, not on behalf of his company. Only lobbyists are authorized to speak on behalf of their companies.

Another factor to consider is whether the employee is being <u>compensated</u> to lobby for his employer. At the county level, however, we've generally held that the more crucial point is whether lobbying is part of the employee's normal scope of employment.

I hope this helps.
