Re: INQ 09-170, County Vendor Registration

Dear Ms. Vega-Pulles:

In correspondence to our office on October 14, 2009, you stated that you wish to register your company, ACE PROPERTY SERVICES, CORP., as a County vendor. Since neither you nor any of your immediate family is employed by Miami-Dade County, you are not required to obtain an ethics opinion from the Commission on Ethics to register as a County vendor.

You stated that you and your husband, Carlos Pulles, are the sole owners of ACE PROPERTY SERVICES, CORP., a company that provides roofing and pest control services. Neither of you is employed by Miami-Dade County nor do either of you have immediate family members employed by Miami-Dade County. Your mother-in-law, Leticia Pulles, is employed by the Miami-Dade Board of Education as a school bus driver.

Employees of the Board of Education do not fall within the jurisdiction of the Miami-Dade County Code of Ethics. The Code of Ethics identifies conflicts of interests related to County employees and their immediate family members. School Board employees are *not* County employees.
