Re: INQ 09-36 Registering as a County Vendor

Dear Ms. Williams:

In correspondence to our office on March 12, 2009, you said that you wish to register your company, PRTTYEYEZ, INC., as a County vendor.

The facts as we understand them are as follows:

- You are employed by the Miami-Dade County TRANSIT AGENCY as a BUS STOCK CLERK.
- PRTTYEYEZ, INC., is a business owned partially by you and in which you serve as President.
- PRTTYEYEZ, INC., deals in recycling remediation, janitorial work, and business and government communications.

It is the opinion of the Ethics Commission staff that PRTTYEYEZ, INC., may register to contract with the County as long as any contract does not interfere with the full and faithful discharge of your duties to the County. This includes the condition that you not participate in determining the contract requirements or in awarding the contract. Additionally, none of your job responsibilities and job descriptions may require you to be involved in the contract in any way including, but not limited to, its enforcement, oversight, administration, amendment, extension, termination, or forbearance. Finally, you may not work in any County department that will enforce, oversee, or administer the contract. In other words, **as long as you are employed by the TRANSIT AGENCY, your company may not contract with the TRANSIT AGENCY.**
