It may be more of an HR question than an ethics question. There is no section in the ethics code that holds a part-time employee in one County department is prohibited from working on a project in another County department. In fact, the rules on outside/conflicting employment only apply to full-time employees — our office, however, is asking the County Commission to amend this rule to cover part-time employees. Therefore, no conflict of interest is created if you were to join one of the teams responding to the RFP, but I can certainly understand your hesitancy in doing so. As far as the second option is concerned, it is the more prudent choice based on your misgivings about perceived conflicts of interest.
