I spoke to one of the Assistant County Attorneys on June 28 in the middle of a meeting of the Housing Finance Authority about whether one of its members, Debra Sinkle Kolsky, owner and president of a Redevco (a real estate development organization) had a voting conflict tied an application brought to the HFA by developer who has been in discussions with Ms. Sinkle Kolsky to work together on an unrelated project. I spoke to Ms. Sinkle Kolsky as well and prohibiting her from voting would have caused the HFA to lose its quorum. I opined that the discussions between the developer and Ms. Sinkle Kolsky were preliminary in nature and given that no agreement was in place, she had no voting conflict and she could participate in the discussions and vote on the project before HFA.
