I spoke to Miguel de Grandy on Friday, April 9th and he wanted to know whether he was engaged in lobbying when he is representing a client who is owed money from Jackson Memorial Hospital. According to Mr. de Grandy, his client is a contractor who has not been fully paid for the work he performed and Mr. de Grandy is going to send JMHS a demand letter and he if gets no response or a satisfactory resolution is not reached, he will file a lawsuit.

I spoke to Michael Murawski and Miriam Ramos and the three of us agreed that Mr. de Grandy is not lobbying County officials when he is asserting a breach of contract claim against the County hospital. This is strictly a legal matter and was not contemplated as one of the activities covered by the County's Lobbyist Registration and Reporting Ordinance. Therefore, Mr. de Grandy was advised that he did not have to register.
