As we discussed this morning, your ability to engage in outside employment as a private real estate agent is at the sole discretion of your supervisor and department director. It is within the authority of your department director to make a blanket prohibition that prevents employees who work for the County's Real Estate Development Division from activating their real estate licenses for private purposes. The Ethics Commission is prohibited by Sec. 2-1067 of the County Code from resolving personnel matters.

Attached is Administrative Order 7-1 that establishes the policy regarding outside employment. A similar statement in the County Ethics Code at Sec. 2-11.1 (j) seeks to ensure that outside employment will not impair an employee's independence of judgment in the performance of his or her public duties.

I hope these guidelines are helpful.
