- Jack Morrow, Medley Vice-Mayor (who is a nonvoting member of the Town Council and also serves as Town Clerk)
- Town of Medley employees
- Michael Pizzi, Town Attorney

The purpose of this meeting is to determine whether a new contract with Waste Management will return enough money to the Town to satisfy the purchase of a property owned by Mr. Dunn. The Town of Medley currently rents a property owned by Mr. Dunn to house approximately 80 trailers for use by senior residents.
