Adrienne F. Promoff, a member of Community Council #2, asked if any ethics conflicts would be created if representatives of the home owners' association that she belongs to spoke at a Community Council #2 meeting.

Representatives of the home owners' association plan to voice an opinion regarding the rezoning a large private property. The subject property is in the vicinity, but not part of the home owners' association. The Council member's husband is active in the home owners' association, but he does not plan to speak.

I advised the Council member that no ethics conflicts were created if representatives of the home owners' association spoke for or against rezoning.

She may also vote on the matter because she has none of the enumerated relationships with the subject property, and she would not be affected differently from the public generally by the rezoning. According to Ms. Promoff, she is within 1% to 2% of the size of the class that would be affected by the vote.
