Former County Attorney Murray asked whether he would be required to register as a lobbyist under the County ordinance where he is representing a private client that has an interest in changing the county charter. Mr. Greenberg expects to be meeting with members of the county attorney's office staff to discuss the wording of a particular proprosal in which his client his interested. He will not be meeting with or lobbying elected officials, but, at some point, the County Commission would have to vote on at charter change proposal preliminary to its being put on the ballot. Therefore, I advised Mr. Greenberg that his interactions with the County Attorney's Office, in pursuance of modifications or changes in the language of a proposal that would foreseeably come up for a vote by the County Commission, would require him to register uner Section 2-11.1(s) of the county code.
