Hello Mr. Foeman,

Nothing in the County Ethics Code or County Campaign Ordinance prohibits the City from renting a space at the Coral Gables Farmers' Market to a candidate for public office in the City of Coral Gables. The candidate, who is not currently a City elected official but is a City advisory board member, intends to hand out campaign literature and promote his candidacy at the Farmers' Market. We understand that the transaction will be at arm's length with no special consideration given to the candidate. *See* County Code at Sec. 2-11.1 (g).

Because a vendor tent at the Farmers' Market could arguably be considered "a building owned by a governmental entity," we caution the candidate that Fla. Stat. 106.15 (4) prohibits candidates from accepting political contributions in buildings owned by a governmental entity.
